Maria came to WorkBC in early 2024. She had been working in a camp-based position as an Environmental Scientist/Professional, a role that is often seasonal.

"I was recently laid off and unsure of what my next steps would be. At first, I didn't think the services would apply to someone in my position—I had a master's degree and some experience behind me, and I assumed the services were more geared toward those who may be just starting out. But I quickly realized that the services and guidance offered are truly for everyone, no matter where you're at in your career journey. It made a huge difference knowing I wasn't alone, and that there was support available to help me move forward".

Maria was encountering barriers in her previous line of work. Traveling, staying in camp, and performing fieldwork no longer felt like the right fit. In meeting with WorkBC, we explored potential career paths better suited to Maria's lifestyle and future goals.

"I really enjoyed working with Keely— she's amazing! Having someone to talk to about my goals, my vision for the future, and the kind of work that would truly fit my personality and interests made a big difference. She helped me identify the types of roles where I could

really use my skills and knowledge in the best way and she definitely has a genuine interest in getting to know you and helping you succeed."

In addition to personalized support, Maria participated in workshops and was supported taking further education at Coast Mountain college.

"I also got a lot out of the Communications workshop at WorkBC—it's one of those things that's helpful for literally everyone. I'm incredibly grateful to have accessed funding for additional training, including a Project Management course, which I'm already applying in my current role, and an Indigenous Awareness course that was a great course as well. I've honestly gained so much from the services."

Maria has now found sustainable employment in a field that remains within environmental sciences, but in a role where she truly excels.

"I'm currently working with the project management team at an environmental consulting company. For a long time, I believed I had to work in the field because I had studied sciences—but it just wasn't the right fit for me. Talking with Keely helped me realize that there were other options out there—roles where I could still use my technical skills and educational background, but in a way that aligned better with who I am and how I like to work. Making that pivot has been incredibly empowering. I feel more fulfilled, more confident in my career path, and excited to learn and grow in my career!"

Through accessing services at WorkBC, Maria found employment, built new skills, and

gained confidence in how she wants to move forward in her professional life.

"I'm really proud of staying true to myself and not giving up. Even when I wasn't employed, I kept learning, growing, and reflecting. I'm proud that I was able to be humble enough to reach out and ask for help—even when I wasn't sure if those resources were meant for someone like me. Most of all, I'm proud that I took the time to reassess my goals and let go of the version of success I thought I had to follow. It's exciting to be stepping into a career path that actually fits who I am, where I can thrive and still use everything I've worked so hard to build."

Maria's journey is a testament to the power of self-reflection, adaptability, and the value of reaching out for support. By embracing change and exploring new possibilities, Maria not only found a role that aligns with her skills and values but also rediscovered a sense of purpose and confidence in her career. 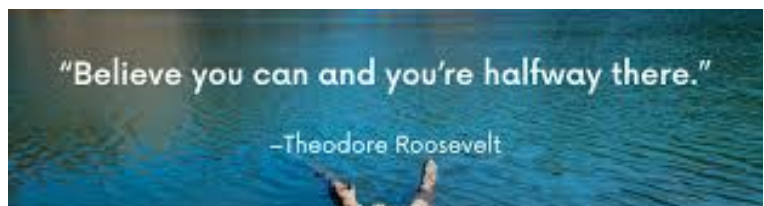
